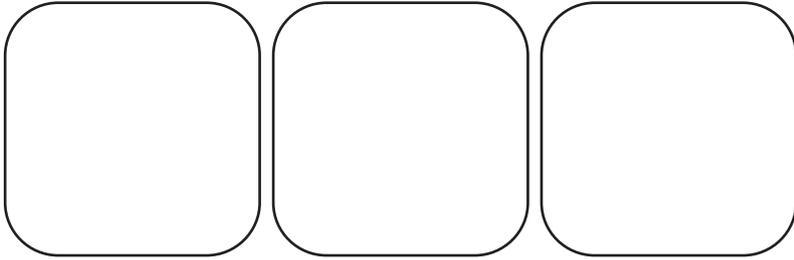


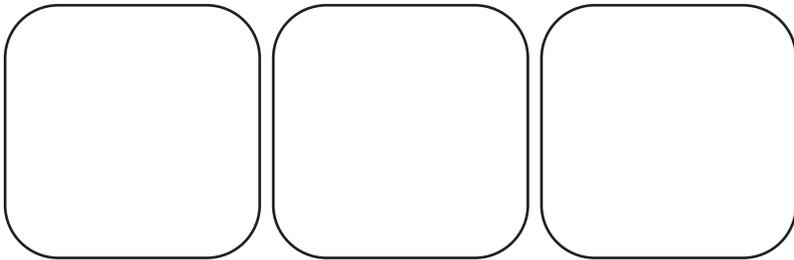

Use this grouping strategy to help you work out these questions. Cut and stick the oranges in the groups or use counters to work out your answer.

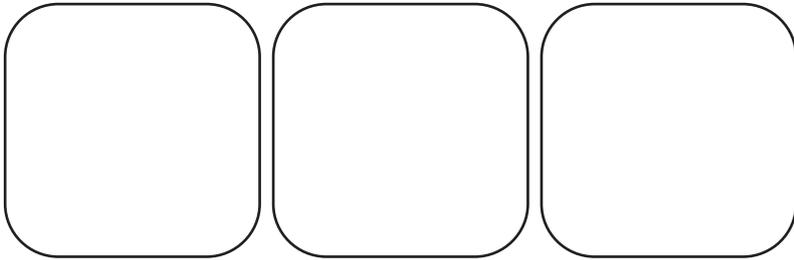
